

The HOUSING ASSISTANCE COUNCIL


- improves housing conditions for the rural poor, with an emphasis on the poorest of the poor in the most rural places in the United States.

POVERTY IN THE UNITED STATES, 2000




POVERTY IN THE UNITED STATES, 2010



POVERTY IN THE UNITED STATES, 1990




POVERTY IN THE UNITED STATES, 1970




Persistent Poverty in the United States, 1990 - 2010




Poverty Rates by Race & Ethnicity, 2010


OVER 45 PERCENT OF RURAL FAMILIES IN POVERTY OWN THEIR HOMES





