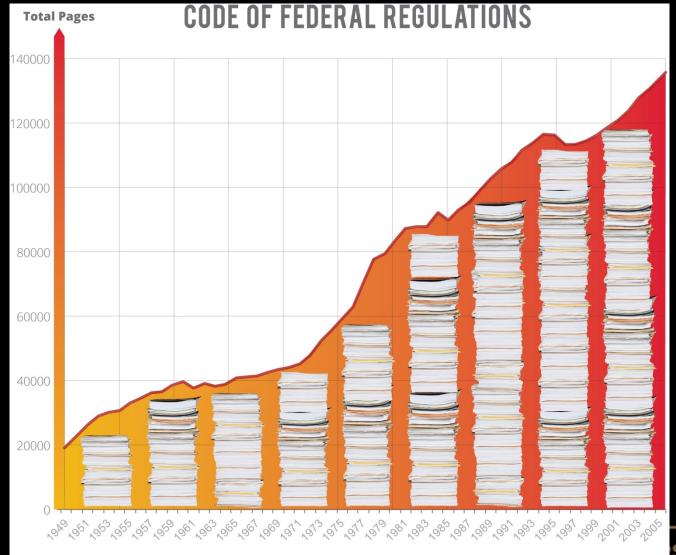

• Results:

 Regulations have reduced real GDP growth an average of 2% per year.

 Real GDP in 2005 would have been \$53.9 trillion instead of the \$15.1 trillion















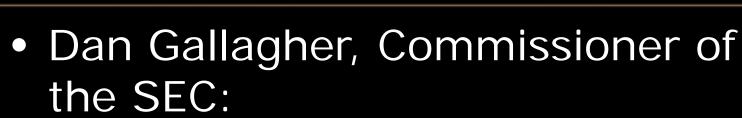
