

In 10 years, Mississippi's population under the age of 19 will be significantly Minority



Nearly half of Mississippi's African American Children Live in Poverty






Louisiana Population Projections



School District Ratings >50% African American




Unemployment Rates for Mississippi's African Americans remain high


Unbanked Households by Race and Geography


Mid South Prime Lending to White and African American Borrowers has been on Decline
